

# Student Dress Code Guidelines

## 2022-2023 School Year

### Daily Uniform

- ★ School-issued polo shirt with school logo
  - Wearing a long-sleeved shirt under the polo is acceptable
- ★ School-issued Cardigan with school logo worn over the polo
- ★ School-issued black dress pants or skort
- ★ Shoes/boots must have closed toes and backs.
  - Clogs or Croc-style shoes are not allowed
  - House shoes or slippers are not allowed

### Head Coverings

- ★ Head covering such as scarves and hats are allowed if they do not have a brim.
  - Headcovers used for sleeping, Du Rags, and Bonnets are not allowed.

### Backpacks/Bags

- ★ Backpacks, purses, and handbags are not permitted in classrooms, nor can they be carried in the hallways between classes. Students should have little reason to be taking items to or from school.

### Special Dress Days

- ★ Clara B. Ford Jogging Pants and Tee-Shirts are acceptable on Fridays (Unless otherwise noted) and Dress Down Days.
- ★ There will be days designated as Dress Down or Free Dress days. Students and advocates will be notified when these days occur and what the dress code will be for the day.

### Special Circumstances

- ★ If a medical issue prevents a student from comfortably wearing the school uniform, please have a medical professional or students advocate contact School Leadership to discuss the issue.
